Suggestions for Care Basket Items

Non-perishables

Canned Tuna
Canned meat, such as Corned Beef, Vienna Sausage
Canned Chicken or Turkey
Cereal
Powdered Milk
Macaroni and Cheese/other boxed meals
Jello, Pudding (ready serve or boxes)
Canned juices, fruits, vegetables, sauces, soups
Pasta and other dry noodle products
Crackers (especially animal crackers)
Microwaveable Popcorn
Packaged Cookies or other packaged treats for kids
Gift certificates for food at various supermarkets

Basic necessities and personal toiletries

Bath soap
Toothpaste
Toothbrushes
Dental Floss
Shampoo
Conditioner
Deodorant
Dish Liquid
Laundry Detergent
Fabric Softener
